## Resolution for Bylaw Change

### Amend the Definition of “Retiree Membership”

**“INTENT”** It is the intent of the Texas Association of Property Inventory Technicians referred to as “T.A.P.E.I.T.” for the duration of this document, to amend the definition of “Retiree Membership”.

**“MEETING”** This resolution shall be posted and voted on during the General Meeting known as “2018 General Board Meeting”, to be held in San Antonio Texas, October 19, 2018.

**“WHEREAS”** The current T.A.P.E.I.T. Bylaws defines “Retiree Membership” under Article 1, Section 2, subsection 2.1.2 as follows:

#### **ARTICLE I MEMBERSHIP**

#### **Section 2 Categories**

##### **2.1.2**

Retirees are considered active members who have retired from their employer. Retirees may vote at any General Membership Meeting and enjoy all benefits and privileges. but may not serve in any capacity in the Association except as a member of the Nomination Committee.

**“WHEREAS”** The current T.A.P.E.I.T Officers and Board are proposing the following changes to the current definition of “Retiree Membership”.

2.1.2 Retirees are considered active members who have retired from their employer. Retirees may vote at any General Membership Meeting and enjoy all benefits and privileges. ~~but may not serve in any capacity in the Association except as a member of the Nomination Committee.~~

**“WHEREAS”** The T.A.P.E.I.T Officers and Board are proposing adding the following language to the current definition of “Retiree Membership”.

##### **2.1.2 (Proposed)**

Retirees are considered active members who have retired from their employer. Retirees may vote at any General Membership Meeting and enjoy all benefits and privileges. ~~but may not serve in any capacity in the Association except as a member of the Nomination Committee.~~

##### **Add 2.1.3**

**Retirees that have served as President are ineligible to return to the Board of Officers.**

#### **Add 2.1.4**

#### **Retirees may serve as member of the Board but not as Executive Officers of the Board.**

**“WHEREAS”** The T.A.P.E.I.T Officers and Board are proposing the new definition of “Retiree Membership” be defined follows:

##### 2.1.2

Retirees are considered active members who have retired from their employer. Retirees may vote at any General Membership Meeting and enjoy all benefits and privileges

##### 2.1.3

Retirees that have served as President are ineligible to return to the Board of Officers.

##### 2.1.4

Retirees may serve as a member of the Board but not as Executive Officers of the Board.

**“WHEREAS”** If approved by the General Membership during the T.A.P.E.I.T General Board meeting to be held October 19, 2018 in San Antonio Texas, this Bylaw would be retroactive to October 1, 2018.
