**Procedures for return of a firearm seized under 573.001 Health and Safety Code.  
Firearms will only be returned to persons who may lawfully possess them under 18  
U.S.C. Sec. 922 (g) and in accordance with Article 18.191 Code of Criminal Procedure.**

1. *The court having jurisdiction to order the commitment will provide this department written notification of their decision.*
2. *If the person is released and can legally possess a firearm in accordance with 18 U.S.C. 922(g), they will be notified by this department.*
3. *If the person is ordered to receive inpatient mental health services, they may:*
  - a. *Petition the court that entered the commitment order for relief under 18 U.S.C. Sec. 922 (g) (4) or;*
  - b. *May designate a person for the firearm(s) to be released and provide a notarized statement releasing the firearm(s) to the designee.*
    - i. *The designed person must provide an affidavit confirming that:*
      1. *They will not allow access to the firearm(s) by the person who was taken into custody at any time during which the person may not lawfully possess a firearm under 18 U. S C. Sec. 922 (g).*
      2. *Acknowledge the responsibility of the designee and no other person to verify whether the person has reestablished the person's eligibility to lawfully possess a firearm.*
      3. *The designee may lawfully possess a firearm under 18 USC 922(g).*
  - c. *May release the firearm(s) to the Lake Worth Police Department for disposition under Article 18.191 Code of Criminal Procedure.*
4. *If a person is wholly or partly owner of the firearm(s), they must:*
  - a. *Provide an affidavit confirming that;*
    - i. *They wholly or partly own the firearm(s)*
    - ii. *Will not allow access to the firearm(s) by the person who was taken into custody under H.S.C 573.001 at any time during which that person may not lawfully possess a firearm.*
    - iii. *Acknowledges the responsibility of the person and no other to verify whether the person who was taken into custody under H.S.C 573.001 has reestablished the person's eligibility to lawfully possess a firearm.*
    - iv. *The person may lawfully possess a firearm under 18 U.S.C. 922 (g).*
5. *If a person to whom written notice is provided does not submit written request to this department for the return of the firearm(s) before the 121<sup>st</sup> day after the date written notice was made, this department may sell the firearm(s) and the proceeds from the sale of the firearm(s) shall be given to the owner of the seized firearm(s), less the cost of administering.*
6. *An unclaimed firearm(s) that was seized from a person taken into custody under Section 573.001 Health and Safety Code may not be destroyed or forfeited to the state.*
